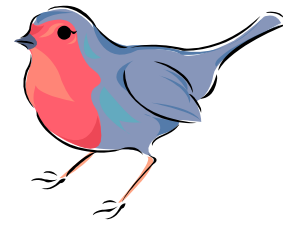


Robins Weekly Plan
